

CCA Jarrard Undergraduate Paper Award Committee invites submission of papers from undergraduate students for the 2017 annual conference that will be held in Clemson, SC.

Guidelines are as follows:

Current or just graduated students are allowed to submit one paper per conference to the Undergraduate paper competition.

The submission is to be a paper written in an undergraduate class.

The paper is to be the original work of the student submitting the paper. Co-authored papers with a faculty member are not eligible for the Jarrard competition.

A student may submit one (1) paper for the Jarrard competition. They may submit additional papers for consideration on a regular panel.

Papers submitted for the Jarrard Undergraduate Paper Award competition must focus on communication. The papers may present studies of any aspect of communication and may use any type of quantitative or qualitative methodology.

The student must attend the conference to present their paper in person.

CCA Jarrard Graduate Paper Award Committee invites submission of papers from graduate students for the 2017 annual conference that will be held in Clemson, SC.

Guidelines are as follows:

Master's students are allowed to submit one paper per conference to the Graduate paper competition.

The submission is to be a paper written in a graduate class.

Papers from MA Theses or Theses projects are not eligible for the Jarrard competition. These papers are eligible for consideration for a regular panel comprised of undergraduate students, graduate students, and/or faculty.

The paper is to be the original work of the student submitting the paper. Co-authored papers with a faculty member are not eligible for the Jarrard competition.

A student whose paper is accepted for presentation may not submit another paper from their graduate work for the Jarrard competition. They may submit additional papers for consideration on a regular panel.

Papers submitted for the Jarrard Graduate Paper Award competition must focus on communication. The papers may present studies of any aspect of communication and may use any type of quantitative or qualitative methodology.

The student must attend the conference to present their paper in person.
